### Reminders for families:)

Just a few reminders for our families in regards to what our caregivers can and cannot help with while at your visits :)

Our caregivers can help cook, bathe, feed, clean up toys, change linens on the consumers bed, clean up meal dishes used to cook for the consumer, go for walks (providing the consumer is not a runner, Safety first), help with homework in the sense that we keep them on task, we are not tutors and cannot do the homework for them :(

Our caregivers cannot administer medications, drive the consumers anywhere in their own cars or your own cars, cannot feed through a G-Tube feeding system and cannot take off their shoes (this is a requirement from our insurance carrier). We provide booties to the caregivers to cover their shoes while in your home. We understand for some families this is religious requirement and we are sorry but there is no way around this policy. Thank you for understanding our policies as they are in place to keep everyone safe!
